Dear Y6 Parents/Carers of returning children,

We last wrote to you on the 18<sup>th</sup> June, and since this letter, there has been changes to guidance from both the government and the unions regarding pupils returning to school. With this in mind, I have met our Governing Body this afternoon to find a way forward.

A thorough risk assessment in-line with Birmingham City Council's guidance, has been undertaken with a main focus on ensuring pupil and staff safety. In order to ensure we are compliant with this risk assessment we have made the decision that Year 6 will not return to school until **Monday 8**<sup>th</sup> of **June, at the earliest.** 

This decision has not been taken lightly and we trust you will understand it was made with the very best of intentions.

We will write to you with further details after half term. The details will include: the confirmed start date, drop of and collection times for your child (should you choose to send them) and what the curriculum will look like. For those parents choosing not to send their child, we will continue with home learning.

Once again, thank you for your support at this time.
